


Carbondale Unitarian Fellowship Using Our Values to Create Our Future

Love is the Overarching Value

We will work to repair harm and damaged relationships. <u>CUF Goal on Interdependence:</u>

Recognize, honor and protect the relationships between ourselves, the Fellowship, the community and planet Earth.

How you live this value:

Equity

<u>UUA Description--</u>We declare that every person has the right to flourish with inherent dignity and worthiness. We covenant to use our time, wisdom, attention, and money to build and sustain fully accessible and inclusive communities.

CUF Goal on Equity:

Develop a community where each person is valued for who they are and provide opportunities for personal growth, spiritual growth and connection; and to promote fully accessible and inclusive communities.

How you live this value:

Justice

<u>UUA Description</u>--We work to be diverse multicultural Beloved Communities where all thrive. We covenant to dismantle racism and all forms of systemic oppression. We support the use of inclusive democratic processes to make decisions within our congregations, our Association, and society at large.

CUF Goal on Justice:

Strive for justice through individual actions, congregational processes, and collaborate with community partners.

Transformation

<u>UUA Description--</u>We adapt to the changing world. We covenant to collectively transform and grow spiritually and ethically. Openness to change is fundamental to our Unitarian and Universalist heritages, never complete and never perfect.

CUF Goal on Transformation:

Create space for change through growth in ourselves, so we may transform our Fellowship, our community and the wider world.

Pluralism

<u>UUA Description</u>--We celebrate that we are all sacred beings diverse in culture, experience, and theology. We covenant to learn from one another in our free and responsible search for truth and meaning. We embrace our differences and commonalities with Love, curiosity, and respect.

Develop ways to welcome and celebrate our differences, support our authentic selves, develop a culture of covenant and embrace diversity in the wider community.

Generosity
